

## **Public Notice**

The New England Youth Theatre has developed a cleanup plan amendment for the 56 Elm Street property, located in Brattleboro, Vermont (SMS# 2010-4099). The cleanup activities are being performed in support of the development of an outdoor classroom to support the theater services. A portion of the cleanup will be funded by an EPA Brownfields Cleanup Grant.

A public meeting to discuss the draft cleanup plan and funding will be held on Thursday, May 11, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. at the New England Youth Theatre, 100 Flat Street, Brattleboro, Vermont.
